Working methods

How do we work with them to identify their needs?

We work with *“creative steps”* – activities

We have questionnaires or interviews by our social workers.



Socializing

- Regular meetings twice a month in KEMOP premises.
- Cultural visits.
- On 18-19/06/2010, we visited the Plastira lake, in Trikala, central east Greece.

“Third-Age people”

We will recall the memory of the old persons and they will narrate local history through their personal life.

This will upgrade their social role, as they come in contact with the new generation.

They will compose their personal history, in photographs exhibition and with other activities, so all these will be transferred to Europe.



Hidden purpose

- **Purpose:** to gain knowledge, attitude and change behavior (if possible), lack of knowledge of the outside world about
- **Knowledge:** to get to know each other better , to be more social and to gain self esteem and self confidence, social competences and cognitive skills.
- **Attitude:** positive attitude to others and to life
- **Behavior:** social behavior, socializing, more human, glad to himself and to the others, active persons in society means active European citizens.



Life experiences

An issue of great importance, both for the individuals themselves as well as the people around them.

Life experience is a special and unique type of knowledge, as it differs for each individual.

Life experiences

- We wanted to give the elderly the **opportunity to feel useful**, by recording and presenting their own experiences, in order to share this small treasure they keep hidden in their hearts and souls with the rest of us.



Life experiences

- Through the process of collecting their experiences, the elderly will be given the opportunity to work together with the social workers, who will be the ones interviewing them.
- They will also be given the opportunity to create something of their own.



Procedure

- We ***hold group meetings*** for the members of the group to get to know one another and to talk.
- We organize ***group excursions to*** forge bonds and create trust among all members.
- Next, we collect the interviews and, finally, ***the experiences of the elderly*** will be presented together with their photos in a printed dossier.

Schools of Special Vocational Education and Training

- Self-reliant schools of Special Education, administered by Secondary Education Administration in Greece.

They are addressed to **students with diagnosed serious special educational needs:**

a) specific handicap (intellectual disorder, intellectual immaturity, sensory problems, autism etc.) ,

b) multiple disabilities (intellectual disorder with sensory problems or with autism),

c) complex cognitive, emotional and social difficulties that are certified by recognized medical educational services.

EEEEK of Nafpaktos

Studies: 5-8 years

Certificate of studies equivalent to the title of obligatory education (certificate of studies in High school) - gives students the chance to work in places that belong to the local authority.

Today at the school there are **32 students** 18-24 years old separated in 5 sections and 6 groups.

There are two **specialisations:**

a) information technology and b) autonomous living

The Nafpaktos EEEEEK aims:

- * to provide students with individualised support,**
- * to foster students' interest to learn,**
- * to help students understand the social and educational context,**
- * to teach students in alternative and attractive ways,**
- * to help students acquire useful skill in order to be able to live autonomously,**
- ∝ to prepare students enter the labour market.**
